

Greenhouse gas emissions reduction at SPC (2020 - 2022)





Over the last two years, the Pacific Community (SPC) has made significant progress in its commitment to reducing greenhouse gas emissions. With a 25% reduction in emissions, SPC has shown its dedication to a sustainable future. In 2020, SPC recorded 1301 tonnes of CO2e (carbon dioxide equivalent) emissions; in 2022, that number dropped to an impressive 968 tonnes of CO2e.




According to SPC's annual Green House Gas inventory, 93% of these emissions are directly related to electricity consumption. This statistic emphasizes the importance of transitioning to more sustainable energy sources in every premise. In Noumea, this work progressed very much in 2020 by installing a photo-voltaic energy generation system.

3 WAYS TO REDUCE OUR CARBON FOOTPRINT AT WORK

- Optimize your air conditioning efficiency by keeping the temperature set at a minimum of 24°C.
- If you travel by plane, you can reduce your emissions by booking a direct flight. They require less fuel than itineraries with multiple legs.
- Avoid printing: if you print, make sure it's double-sided.
- Don't forget to turn off electrical appliances when not in use.
