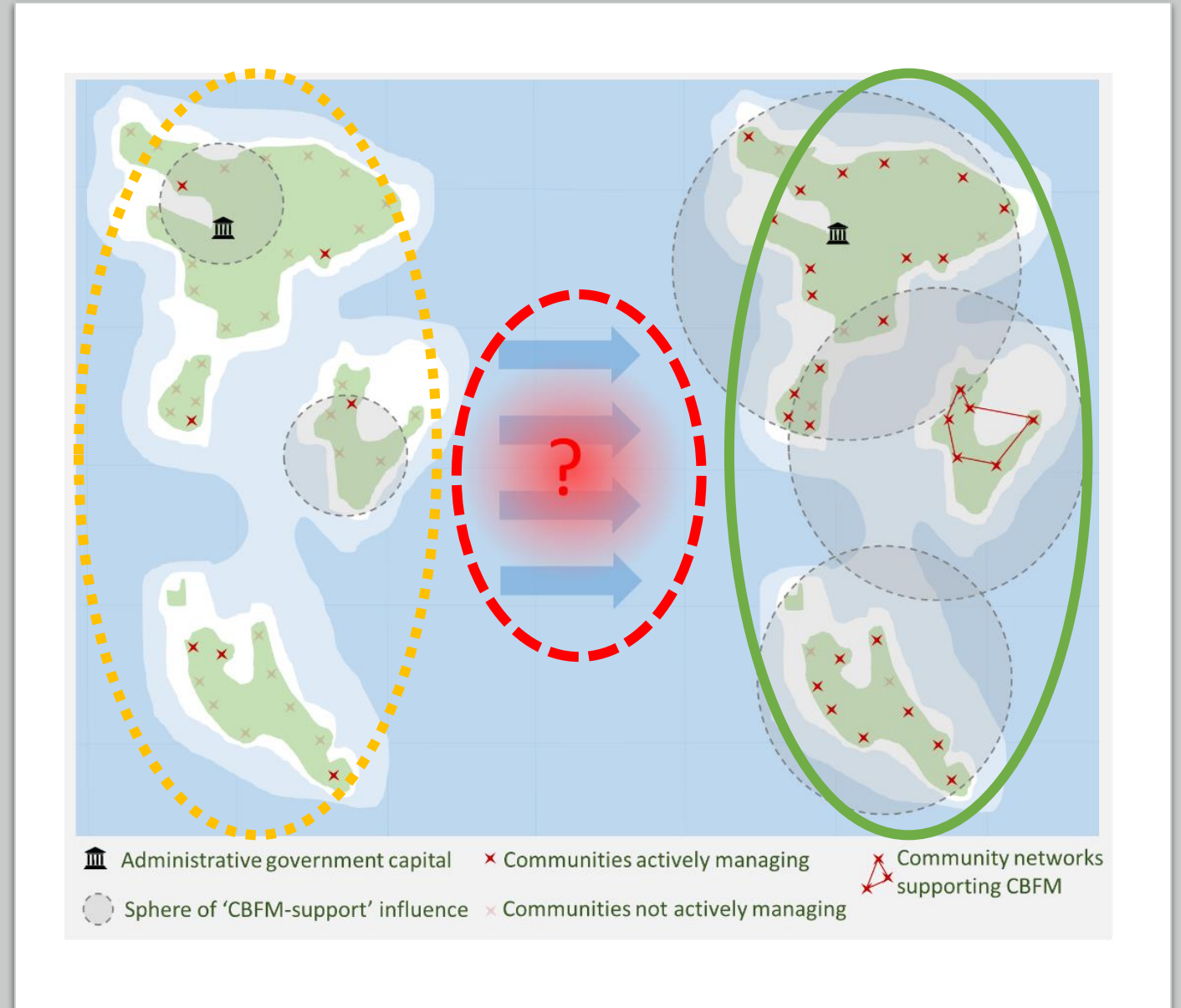

To improve wellbeing of communities and healthy ecosystems and fish stocks





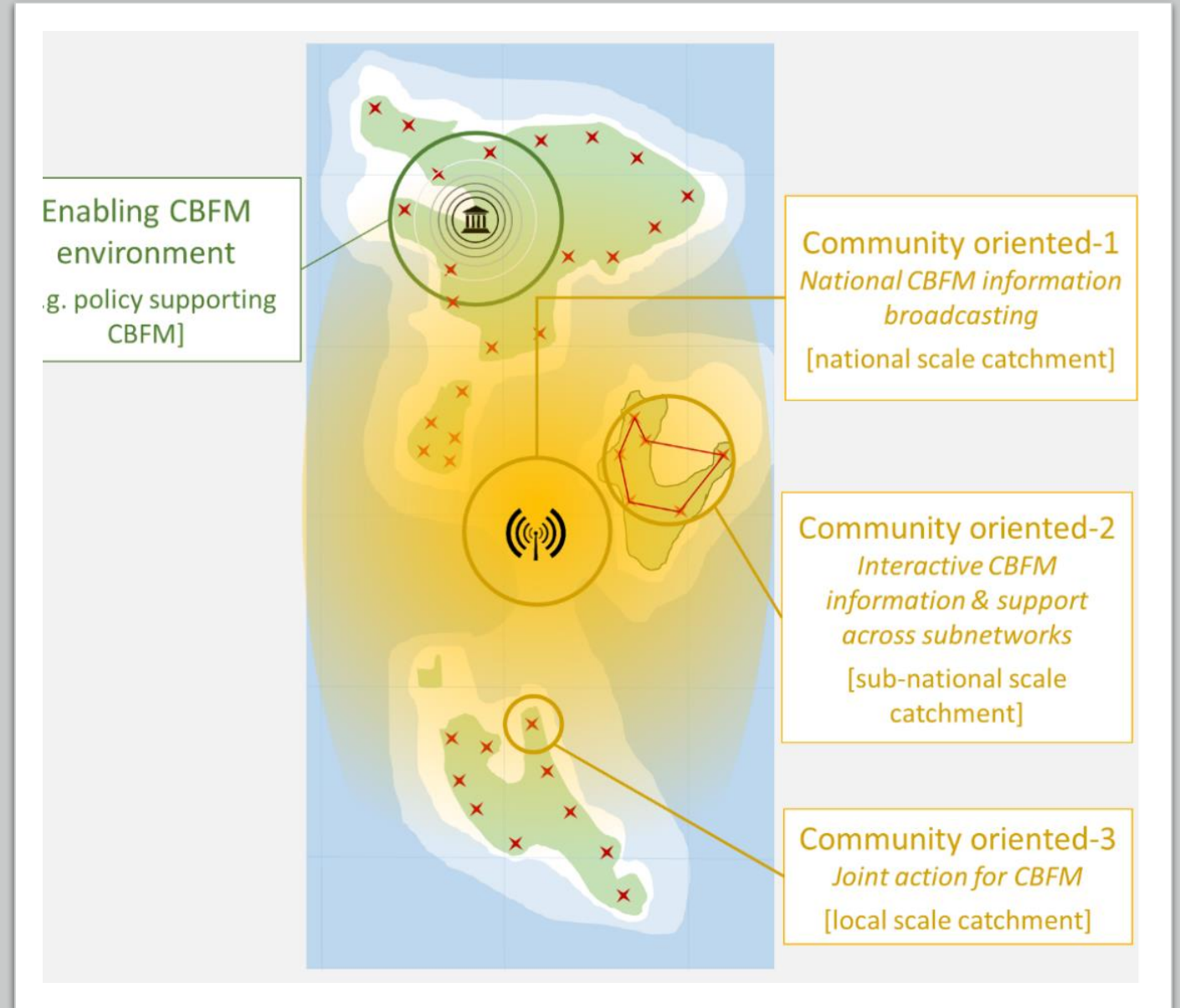
Scaling up strategic approaches we have examined
