

Store old tyres under shelter and other old or unused household things like empty drums, motor parts, old refrigerators, bottles and other things to prevent mosquitoes from breeding in them.



Crush tins, bottles and put them with garbage in a hole. Cover with a layer of earth or sand, or protect hole against rain with corrugated iron.



Drain puddles and pour oil or kerosene onto stagnant puddles which cannot be drained.



Clean the bush and plantations. Burn all coconut shells and other waste that can be burned.

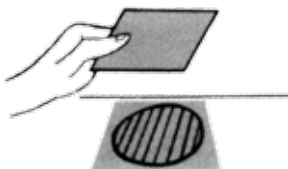
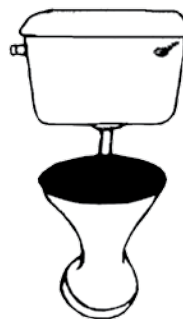


Fill in any holes (e.g. Holes dug by crabs, tree holes, puddles.)

UNOCCUPIED OR VACANT PREMISES

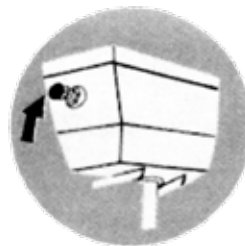


Toilet bowls should be tightly covered to prevent mosquitoes breeding in water.



Gully traps and floor traps should also be covered to prevent mosquitoes breeding.

The overflow pipe of the flushing cistern should be sealed off with rubber or plastic cap.

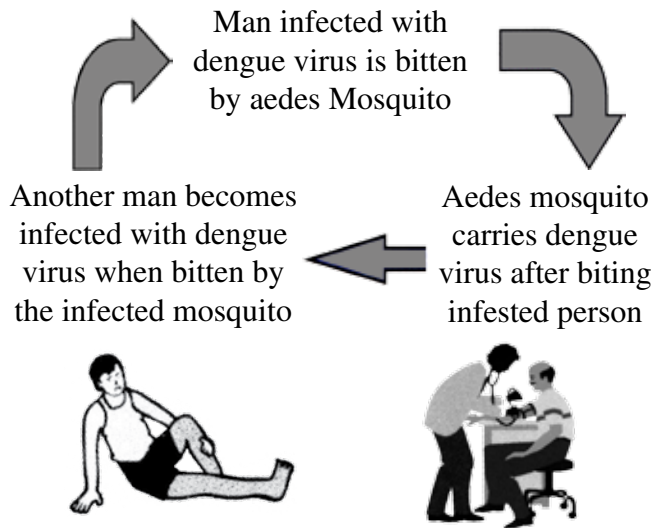

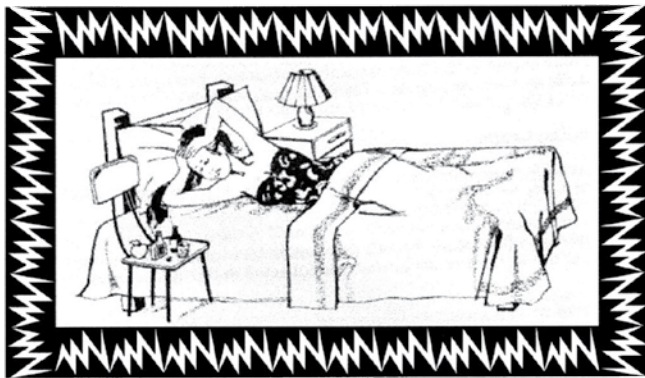

HERE ARE SOME SIGNS THAT YOU MAY HAVE DENGUE



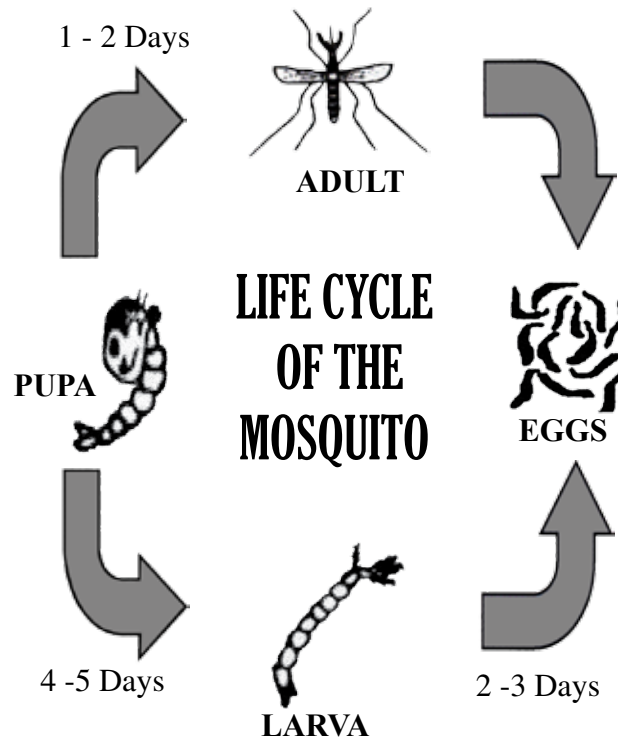
- Sudden high fever
- Pain in muscles and joints
- Severe headache and backache
- Pain on moving the eye
- A rash with or without itching

DENGUE FEVER

AEDES MOSQUITO



- It has black and white stripes on its body.
- It bites mostly during day time.
- It breeds in stagnant water.
- The adult mosquito emerges 7 days after the egg is laid in

Eg: Cans, Tins, Bottles, Coconut Shells, Tyres, Pot Plants etc...

Change the water in flower vases weekly and wash the vases thoroughly before refilling them with fresh water.



Get rid of water from flower pot plates at least once weekly and scrub them thoroughly to get rid of mosquito eggs.

Cover all water containers to prevent mosquitoes from breeding in them.
