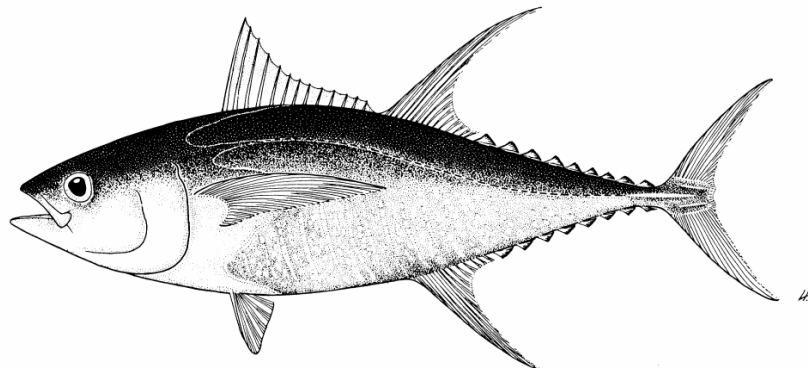

INTRODUCTION

Some information about the SPC-Noumea Library

SPC-Noumea library dates back to the creation of SPC itself, and one of the strengths of the collection is its continuity over the lifespan of the organisation. The archival section of the headquarters library holds most SPC corporate documents, the majority of all SPC publications, manuscript proceedings of unpublished conferences, meetings or workshops, and other ephemeral materials produced in association with various SPC projects over the last 50 years.

The current collection has regional and international publications in French, English and, to a limited extent, in some Pacific languages. Totalling nearly 34,000 monographs and 382 active journal subscriptions, the library's collection is a resource facility for SPC staff and reflects the organisation's work. In the marine sciences we collect materials on coastal and oceanic fisheries, aquaculture of seaweed, finfish, crustaceans and invertebrates, safety at sea, women in fisheries, and seafaring. The Library receives fisheries materials from FAO, and fisheries and safety at sea materials from the ILO and from regional bodies such as FFA, SPREP, SOPAC and the Pacific Islands Forum Secretariat. Of the total collection, one quarter is on marine science and fisheries, making up the largest subject area collection in the library.

Key features of the library service are reference and research, bibliographies, document delivery, acquisitions, cataloguing, and the preparation of cataloguing-in-publication data for SPC publications. SPC library will provide research on both subscription and free databases on all the topics and subject areas addressed by SPC's projects and programmes. The library has access to EBSCO databases, the DIALOG collection, which includes important databases such as BIOSIS, and a wide spectrum of free databases such as AGRIS. Since early 2005, the Library has been a contributor to ASFA (Aquatic Sciences and Fisheries Abstracts), and will be responsible for entering bibliographic information on SPC publications in all areas of fisheries, including aquaculture.

Scope of this bibliography

This bibliography primarily focuses on documents held at the SPC-Noumea library, covering a number of issues relating to fisheries in a broad sense. Some of the documents are unpublished reports or "grey literature". This bibliography was compiled using DB/Text software.

The bibliography provides separate listings by author in alphabetical and chronological order, categorised (1) under country names (SPC Pacific Island member countries and territories) and (2) under subject headings.

Indexes to authors and organisations mentioned in the bibliography are also provided, as well as a list of acronyms and abbreviations used. For the author index, the page indexed may contain one or more occurrences of the author. The same applies to the organisation index.
