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
INTRODUCTION

In September 2021, a national census of population and housing was conducted in the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI). The Marshall Islands Census of Population and Dwellings is conducted by the country's statistics agency, the Economic, Planning, Policy and Statistics Office (EPPSO). It provides an official count of people, along with demographic and socioeconomic information at the atoll/island and community level. It is the 12th census of population to be undertaken after the first census enumeration was undertaken in the Republic of the Marshall Islands in 1920.

The census supports EPPSO's mission of "serving as an economic advisor to the Government of the Republic of the Marshall Islands".

The Marshall Islands decennial Census of Population and Housing is central to decisions in all areas of society and government decision making. It is designed to take an inventory of the total population and housing units in the RMI and to collect information about their characteristics and is the basis of population estimates; it provides insight into the wellbeing and needs of communities throughout the Marshallese society.

GLOSSARY

Census	The total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analysing and publishing or otherwise, disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country or in a well-delimited part of a country.
Disability	People with disability categorise as compilation of two level of difficulties – a lot of difficulties and cannot do at all specified as disability. Persons with disabilities include those who have long-term physical, mental, intellectual, or sensory impairments which in interaction with various barriers may hinder their full and effective participation in society on an equal basis with others.”
Atoll/Island	The atolls/or main islands in the Republic of the Marshall Islands.
Economic activity	The main activity each person aged 15 years and older did during the reference week. Economically active People who were either engaged in a full or part-time job or in a business, engaged mainly in farming, fishing or handicrafts making, or mainly in housework with some gardening or farming, fishing or making handicrafts, who had a job but were on leave or temporary absent for some reason, and the unemployed.
Employed Population	Those who ‘work for pay’ or ‘work to support the household by producing goods for sale’, or ‘work to support the household for own consumption.
Ethnicity	Relates to the ethnic group a person belongs to
Household	Consists of persons who usually eat together and share the work of preparing the food and/or the cost of work of providing it. Generally, household members live and sleep in the same building although this is not always the case. Hence, the definition is based on sharing a meal together rather than on living or sleeping in the same building or dwelling.
Household head	The person with the primary authority and responsibility for household affairs. This person is usually designated by the members of the household.
Industry	The main activity undertaken by the establishment or place where a person worked. Industry affiliation was classified according to the International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC) Revision 4_2004.
Institution	A place of residence apart from private HH, such as hotel/motels, hospital and prison.
Not economic active	People who were neither employed nor unemployed. This includes those engaged in housework only, full time students, the retired, the disabled and other.
Paid work	The work a person carries out in order to gain wages, salaries or cash.
Urban population	Total population of the Atolls of Majuro and Ebeye.
Rural population	Total population of outer islands in Marshall Islands excluding (Kwajalein and Majuro).


