





Population distribution




National Sex Ratio


Palaun sex ratio

Migrant sex ratio











National level 15+ median wage and major occupation group


Females earn 6% more than males in higher position, and 8% more in medium ones





Median wage (US\$ per hour) by occupation level







³ The Washington Group Short Set on Functioning (WG-SS) identifies persons 5+ years, who declare having difficulties in at least one of the six core domains of functioning: seeing, hearing, walking, cognition, self-care, and communication. Responses include 'No difficulty', 'Some difficulty', 'A lot of difficulty', and 'Cannot do at all'. Disability is classified according to whether a respondent has at least 'a lot of difficulty' on at least one of the six questions.
